## Getting to University of Hull: Public Transport....

Hull Campus – Main Entrance is on the Cottingham Road.

Buses run regularly from Hull Paragon (Train & Bus Interchange) to the University.

You need :

- the 105 (stop is “Old Grey Mare”), or
- 15/115/215 (stop is “Cranbrook Avenue”).

East Yorkshire buses (105, 115, 215) charge £1.50 (single), £2.70 (return).

Stagecoach buses (15) charge £1.40 single

Taxis charge a minimum of £5.00 from Hull Paragon to the University.

You may find a taxi outside the interchange.
